Hello,

A press release from Maine DEP was mailed with the April 2020 billing explaining how important properly functioning sewer systems are to protect public health and also reduce the spread of COVID 19.

DEP listed the following products that should not be flushed:

- Baby wipes/cleaning wipes
- Paper towels
- Tissues
- Dental floss
- Tampons and sanitary products
- Cotton balls and swabs
- Cat litter
- Prescription drugs
- Over-the-counter medicines
- Cigarette butts

Since October 2020, there have been numerous alarms at the North Main Pump Station which required pumping out/cleaning the pump station, pulling the pumps for inspection and finding hair clogs, an ace bandage, socks, rags, and/or grease in the pump components.

Please make sure only toilet paper is being flushed and other items are properly disposed of.
